

Minutes of the Regional Sports Control Board Meeting (Gurugram Region) for conduct of Regional Sports Meet 2018-19

Meeting of the Regional Sports Control Board was held on 28/02/2018 at 02:00 PM at KV No.1, AFS, Gurugram under the Chairmanship of Mr. S. S. Rawat, Deputy Commissioner, KVS RO Gurugram. The following members attended the meeting:

Confirmation of Minutes of previous meeting :

Minutes of the previous meeting held on 05.04.2017 were read out and all points were confirmed by the committee. Mr. C. S. Azad, Assistant Commissioner and Member Secretary of Regional Sports Control Board welcomed the members and spelt out the purpose of the meeting.

The Member Secretary, Mr.C.S. Azad proudly shared the achievements of the region with the committee in the 48th KVS National Sports Meet-2017. He informed that **394** boys and **291** girl students of Gurugram region participated in 48th KVS National Sports Meet and **34** boys and **28** girl students were selected for SGFI. Out of these 62 students, **1** boy got **SILVER** medal and **1** girl got **BRONZE** medal in **National School Games-2017** conducted by SGFI.

He invited Hon'ble Deputy Commissioner, Mr. S. S. Rawat to open the discussion. The Chairman Mr. S. S. Rawat, congratulated everybody for the grand success of the KVS National Sports Meet and SGFI Meet 2017. He impressed upon everyone that by meticulous planning and befitting implementations any target could be achieved. With a word of caution against the casual attitude of some teachers, he invited suggestions and innovative ideas from all members for the smooth conduct of the Regional Sports Meet 2018- 19. Resolutions taken in the meeting must be implemented in letter and spirit and the meeting of RSCB should not be for name sake. He emphasized on skill development of players by identifying the talent among students.

Agenda points for the meeting were discussed one by one and the following decisions were taken:

1. Selection Process of Regional Teams for KVS NSM

- (a) **Team Events (U/14) (Boys & Girls)**- The Regional Sports Meet winner vidyalaya team will participate in 49th KVS National Sports Meet-2018
- (b) **Team Events (U/19) (Boys & Girls)**- The vidyalaya team will participate at Regional Sports Meet and mixed team comprising best players of the Region will be selected for 49th KVS National Sports Meet-2018.
- (c) **For Individual/Semi Team Events (U/14,17 & 19)**- The existing system of Bench mark will continue. Bench mark will be 6th Place in the individual event in 2017 Regional Sports Meet of Gurugram Region and same will be informed in due course.

2. (a) The committee stressed upon the need for the selection of teams by 15th April at school level. List of selected players event wise should be displayed on vidyalaya website as per proforma provided by KVS (HQs) latest by 16th April 2018 well before the Regional Meet 2018, scheduled to be conducted on 26th, 27th, 28th April 2018(Tentative dates).
- (b) The Chairman emphasized upon the need for providing all the sports equipments for practice to students by the Vidyalayas. In no case students should be asked to bring

equipment from their homes. All the items must be procured by the vidyalayas in sufficient quantity by following prescribed purchase procedure. At the time of purchasing vidyalayas should not stick to one brand only rather quotations may be called for multi brand items.

- (c) **Conduct of Regional Level Coaching Camps During Summer Vacation** : After deliberations, committee arrived at the following decisions:
- (a) During Summer Vacation 10 days Coaching Camp at Regional Level will be organized for selected players who will participate at KVS National Sports Meet 2018. These camps would be conducted during summer vacation. Coaching Camp for (U/14) team games will be organized at vidyalaya level for 10 days. To coach for team games, fit and skilled Physical Education Teachers will be deputed for enhancing performance of talented and selected players.
- (b) Students appearing in class 10th examination-2018 are also to be permitted to participate in Regional/49th KVS National Sports Meet 2018 till his/her name is there on Vidyalaya roll.
- (d) **Selection of Regional Teams for National Sports Meet**
Specialized selectors should be invited from outside from recognized sports associations of District/State/National level. Selection of players should be fair and list of stand bys should be prepared with area of their specialization against their names so that in case of withdrawal of a player, he may be substituted by the stand by player(s) having same specialization/skill.
- (e) **Proposed Venues for Regional Sports Meet-** As per the discussion held in the NSCB, Regional Sports Meet will now be conducted in the nearby Stadium/Sports Colleges of Govt./Govt. Semi/IHL(IIT, NIIT etc)/Sports institutes for which tender has already been floated on 14.03.2018 as per HQ guidelines.

**Tentative Dates for Regional Sports Meet are – 26th, 27th and 28th, April 2018.*

Category of Football-Boys & Girls (U/17) is for Subroto Cup Only and Hockey-Boys(U/15) is for Nehru Cup.

Cricket and Athletics meets would be conducted for four days from 25th to 28th April 2018.

In cricket, league matches will be of at least of 15 overs and 20 overs at Semifinals and Final stage.

6. Arrangements of boarding & lodging during RSM, National Coaching Camp & NSM 2018:

Boarding and lodging arrangements will be made by the venue management as per KVS guidelines.

7. Appointment of Observers

Just like last year, this year also a few Principals will be appointed as observers for the venues having more than 200 participants. List of observers will be circulated in due course.

8. Organizing Cultural Activities

Cultural activities such as poem recitation, speech, solo songs, group songs, movie viewing, dances etc. should be organized in the evening for the entertainment of players.

9. Reservation for KVS National Sports Meet 2018

Keeping in view KVS National Sports Meet 2018 dates and venues it will be the sole responsibility of National Coaching Camp Venue Principal to confirm the seats for the participants and they should collect all the required information from Regional Sports Meet Venue Principals.

10. Development of Sports Infrastructure in KVs

While taking up this point it was deliberated upon by worthy Chairman of RSCB that every KV should develop fundamental sports infrastructure. For the approval of construction, it is required that KV Principals may send their proposals with complete check list i.e. land plan, map and estimates in AE part I & II to the Regional Office.

11. Primary Section Cluster Level Sports Meet under CMP

It was decided that Cluster Level Sports Meet for Primary wing may be conducted in the month of November preferably on Children's Day i.e. 14th November 2018 and DA norms will be followed as per KVS rules. Adequate sports equipments (as per the budget) should be provided to the students of Primary Section as per KVS norms.

12. Adventure Activities

The Chairman advised the Principals to take initiatives to plan and conduct the adventure activities positively during academic session 2018-19. Permission letters may be sent to this office for sending the

students for adventure activities as per KVS rules latest by 15th April 2018. Expenditure will be reimbursed to KVs as per KVS rules in the ratio of 40:40:20 (HQs : RO: VVN).

13. Submission of Sports Bills

It was reiterated that sports bills of National/Regional Sports Meet along with all the relevant vouchers in original must be submitted within 30 days after completion of meet/camp to RO by the concerned KVs.

14. Information regarding Regional/National Sports Meet


Circulars or instructions if any issued by KVS HQs regarding Regional/National Sports Meet will be forwarded to all KVs with details such as venue, dates and other modalities.

15. Distribution of Sports Kit & Shoes

It was decided that KVs will provide T-Shirts, Shorts, Joggers/Specific Shoes to the players. Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball players should also be provided Knee Caps/ Anklets. Escorting TGT(P&HE) /Escorts/Coaches will be provided sports kit as per KVS HQs instructions for 49th KVS NSM 2018.

The meeting ended on a promising note assuring better performance in the upcoming Regional and 49th National Sports Meet 2018. Mrs. Kumud Srivastava, Assistant Commissioner, KVS RO Gurugram Region proposed the vote of thanks for fruitful and valuable inputs provided by the committee members. She also thanked special invitees present in the meeting for their contribution and valuable suggestions.
